We at Textron Specialized Vehicles Inc. and Pace Technology (collectively, "Pace", "us", "our", or "we") are strongly committed to transparency, and we want you ("you" or "your") to understand how we collect, use, share and protect your Personal Data (as defined below), as well as the rights and choices you have with respect to your Personal Data and how you can contact us to get answers to your questions.

This Privacy Notice applies to information we obtain in various contexts, both online and offline, including when you: (i) access, use, or otherwise interact with our web portal and/or any Pace products, devices, technologies, solutions, and features (collectively, the "Services"); (ii) purchase our Services; (iii) visit or use any applications or services that link to this Privacy Notice; (iv) interact or communicate with us; (v) engage with us on social media; (vi) sign up to receive marketing communications; (vii) interact with our advertising and marketing materials; (viii) participate in any of our programs or events; (ix) fill out surveys, or enter into contests or other promotions; or (x) otherwise submit information to us or through the Services. This Privacy Notice also applies to information we collect automatically as you and others navigate through and interact with our Services and from third parties.

Our Services capture information, including Personal Data, about you and possibly other individuals if they are also using the Services or are in close proximity to you, such as if you or your caddie operate and use one or more Pace devices or a vehicle equipped with such device(s) (e.g., golf cart) or where a Pace device is affixed to you or your caddie's person or equipment (e.g., a compact device carried by you or your caddie or otherwise affixed to your golf bag that offers precise locating ability while you and your caddie are on a golf course).

BY ACCESSING OR USING OUR SERVICES, INCLUDING WHEN PLAYING AT A GOLF COURSE THAT UTILIZES PACE PRODUCTS OR TECHNOLOGIES, CARRYING OR AFFIXING A PACE DEVICE ON SOMEONE'S PERSON OR PERSONAL PROPERTY WHILE PLAYING AT A GOLF COURSE, OR UTILIZING A GOLF CART EQUIPPED WITH PACE PRODUCTS OR TECHNOLOGIES, YOU ACKNOWLEDGE AND UNDERSTAND THAT YOU ARE INTENTIONALLY DIRECTING US TO DISCLOSE YOUR PERSONAL DATA TO THE OWNER OF THE RELEVANT GOLF COURSE OR GOLF CART. Please review the golf course's privacy policy to understand how they use the Personal Data being collected. We have no control over, and are not responsible for, the actions and privacy policy of the golf course.

It is our policy to comply with applicable privacy laws, so our privacy practices may vary depending on where you live. For certain products, services, and features, there may be additional notices about our practices and this Privacy Notice supplements any other privacy policies provided or communicated to you. If you are an employee, independent contractor, or job applicant of Pace, your information collected in those contexts will be separate to a privacy notice that we provide to you where and when appropriate.

By using our Services, you acknowledge the terms of this Privacy Notice. If you do not understand the terms of this Privacy Notice, please do not use our Services. Our Services may include links to websites and/or applications operated and maintained by third parties. California Privacy Law Appendix

1. TYPES OF INFORMATION WE COLLECT

We collect two basic types of information from you when you provide it to us or when you use or interact with our Services or through our advertising and media across the Internet: Personal Data and non-Personal Data.

Personal Data includes all information that relates to you or which are opinions about you personally and either identifies or may be used to identify you personally (collectively, "Personal Data"). We may only collect the following, limited types of information from you depending upon the device you are using and how you interact with us or use or interact with our Services, such as your:

- Contact Information. Name, postal address, email address, phone number, unique personal identifiers (e.g., Golf Handicap Information Network numbers, player ID, etc.), online identifiers, company name, title, and other contact information.
- Demographic Data. Gender.
- **Device Information.** IP address, browser type and version, browser plug-in types and versions, operating system and platform, device type, device identifiers, and information about how you use our Services.
- **General Location Data.** Information generated from your IP address that permits us to determine your general location.
- Participation Details. Information about the courses you play at, dates and times of play, your scores, and information regarding your handicap.
- **Purchase Information.** Customer ID, record of purchases and programs, service schedules, other information as requested to facilitate or complete delivery or to make available and provide ongoing support, maintenance, repair, training, or other Services related to the Services being purchased.
- **Account Information.** If you create an account, we may store and use your name, email address, zip or postal code and other Personal Data you may provide with your account. You can modify some of the Personal Data associated with your account. If you believe that someone has created an unauthorized account, you can request its removal.
- **Geolocation & Performance Information.** Automatically collected data from the Pace solutions in your golf cart, or on Pace devices carried by or otherwise affixed to your or your caddie's person or personal belongings on a golf course that includes precise location data (such as your and/or your caddie's physical movements on a golf course in real-time), maintenance-related data, and numerous signals from the Pace product about its performance.
- **Usage Information.** Data you provide from your use of the Pace solutions, including information about food and beverage orders, music pairing, and the two-way messaging system.
- **Inferences.** Inferences drawn from or created based on any of the information identified in this list to create a profile about, for example, your preferences, characteristics, and predispositions.

To view all of the categories of Personal Data we collect, click <u>here</u>. We strive to uphold data minimization principles and only seek to collect Personal Data from you for the purposes described in this Privacy Notice.

Non-Personal Data includes information that does not personally identify you or information that has been anonymized (collectively, "non-Personal Data"). When we combine non-Personal Data with Personal Data, we treat the combined information as Personal Data.

You can always refuse to provide your Personal Data, but please note that some Personal Data is necessary to provide our Services.

2. HOW WE COLLECT PERSONAL DATA

We need to collect Personal Data from you in order to provide you with our Services, as well as to improve your experience. You may provide us with Personal Data in several ways, including, for example when you:

- Visit our web portal or otherwise use or interact with our Services, including using certain Services when operating a vehicle:
- Register or create an account;
- Correspond with us in any way, including through questionnaires and surveys;
- Sign up to receive our newsletter or promotional information;
- Ask for customer service, support or other assistance; or
- Interact with us in any other way, online or offline, including through our Services.

Cookies

Surveys

From time to time, and subject to your consent where required by applicable local law, we may provide you with the opportunity to participate in surveys. Participation in these surveys is completely voluntary. If you choose to participate, we will request certain Personal Data from you.

3. HOW WE USE PERSONAL DATA

We collect your Personal Data (including limited Sensitive Personal Data) to support our business operations, including for the following purposes:

- to ensure effective administration and management of your relationship with us, including making our Services available to you;
- to personalize our Services to you, including personalized experiences, content, and ads;
- to understand how you use our Services and identify any issues in how the Services are used and how we can improve your experience with our Services;
- to infer characteristics about you
- to facilitate your interactions and transactions with us, such as requests for support or additional Services, as well as to respond to your requests, communications, suggestions, inquiries, and comments (including your feedback about our Services);
- to provide you with information, products, or Services that you request from us;
- to provide you with, and improve, relevant marketing offers or information from us;
- for testing, research, analysis and product development (e.g., new products, features, and Services);
- to better understand and address the preferences of our customers;
- to analyze product performance, maintenance, and operations;
- to maintain, support, troubleshoot, manage and improve our Services;
- to develop and manage relationships with our business partners;
- to ensure our Systems and premises are secure, and to help maintain the safety, security, and integrity of our Services, products, databases and other technology assets, and business;
- to prevent, detect, or investigate unauthorized use of our Services, and to protect against malicious, deceptive, fraudulent, or illegal activity, and prosecute those responsible for that activity;
- to assist in the event of an emergency, and to manage any dispute and accidents and take legal or other professional advice:
- to exercise or defend legal claims, and to respond to legally binding requests from law enforcement, regulatory authorities, or other third parties;
- to carry out our legal and contractual obligations, and to enforce our rights arising from any contracts entered into between you and us (including, but not limited to, any applicable terms of use or service);
- to evaluate or conduct a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of our assets, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation, or similar proceeding, in which Personal Data held by us about you is among the assets transferred.
- to comply with our legal, regulatory, and contractual obligations;
- to fulfill any other purpose for which you provide it;
- for any other purpose with your consent; and
- in any other way we may describe when you provide the information or as otherwise permitted by applicable law.

We may also combine your Personal Data collected through various sources, including information collected through our Services, and develop a customer and/or user profile that will be used for the purposes above.

We may use Personal Data to create non-Personal Data, and we may use non-Personal Data for any legitimate business purpose.

4. HOW WE DISCLOSE PERSONAL DATA

We only disclose Personal Data in limited circumstances as described in this Privacy Notice. For example, we may disclose Personal Data to our corporate affiliates and subsidiaries as well as our third-party service providers, suppliers, professional advisors and/or business partners, which include our golf course customers. However, we do not disclose Personal Data to third parties for their own direct marketing purposes without your consent. We also contract with these parties to ensure that they only process your Personal Data under our instructions and ensure the security and confidentiality of your Personal Data. We disclose Personal Data with these third parties to help us:

- with the uses described in the **How We Use Information** section above;
- in the operation, management, improvement, research and analysis of our Services;
- with our marketing and promotional projects, such as sending you information about products and services you may like and other promotions (provided you have not unsubscribed from receiving marketing and promotional information from us);
- comply with your directions or any consent you have provided us; and
- otherwise fulfill the purpose for which you provide it.

We may disclose Personal Data with law enforcement and regulatory authorities or other third parties as required or permitted by law for the purpose of:

- responding to a subpoena, court order, or other legal processes;
- complying with applicable laws and contractual obligations;
- exercising or defending legal claims;
- defending, protecting, or enforcing our rights;
- protecting the property or safety of Pace, its customers, users, or others; and/or
- assisting in the event of an emergency.

In accordance with applicable law, we may also transfer or assign Personal Data to third parties as a result of, or in connection with, a sale, merger, consolidation, change in control, transfer of assets, bankruptcy, reorganization, or liquidation. If we are involved in defending a legal claim, we may disclose Personal Data about you that is relevant to the claim to third parties as a result of, or in connection with, the associated legal proceedings.

We disclose non-Personal Data with third parties as reasonably necessary to meet our business needs.

Information You Share or Post Online Including Related to Our Services

Please be aware that there are public areas that interact with our Services, such as our social media channels, where individuals may voluntarily disclose Personal Data. This information may be seen and used by others. We encourage everyone to exercise good judgement when using these public areas and sharing Personal Data.

5. HOW WE PROTECT PERSONAL DATA

We are dedicated to ensuring the security of your Personal Data. We use physical, electronic, and administrative security measures appropriate to the risks and sensitivity of the Personal Data we collect. Personal Data is maintained on our servers or those of our service providers, and is accessible by authorized employees, representatives, and agents as necessary for the purposes described in this Privacy Notice. We aim to provide secure transmission of your Personal Data from your devices to our servers. We have processes to store Personal Data that we have collected in secure operating environments. Our security procedures mean that we may occasionally request proof of identity before we disclose your Personal Data to you. While we attempt to protect your Personal Data in our possession, no method of transmission over the internet or security system is perfect, and we cannot promise that information about you will remain secure in all circumstances. If you suspect an unauthorized use or security breach of your Personal Data, please contact us immediately.

For your convenience, some of our Services allow you to remain logged in so that you do not have to re-enter your password each time you want to access your account. If you choose to remain logged in, you should be aware that anyone with access to your device will be able to access, use, and make changes to your account. Verification Process and Required Information

Some of the requests under **Your Choices and Controls** must be verified to confirm the request came from you. We may contact you by phone or e-mail to verify your request. This process may require us to request additional Personal Data from you, including, but not limited to, your email address, mailing address, account name, and/or date of last interaction with us. In certain circumstances, we may decline a request to exercise a privacy right, particularly where we are unable to verify your identity.

Responding to Requests

Once you have submitted your request, we will respond within the time frame permitted by the applicable law. We may charge a reasonable fee for multiple requests in the same 12-month period, as permitted by law.

Authorized Agent

You may designate an authorized agent to submit a request on your behalf.
